**GRADING SYSTEM**

Exam marks are given on a scale with a maximum score of 30 lode (with pass mark of 18).

One Italian credit (CFU - *Credito Formativo Universitario*) corresponds to 25 hours of study time and 60 credits to the workload of a full time student during one academic year.

Please note: at Tuscia University 1 CFU is equal to 1 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).
